### PHYSICAL FACILITIES AND SERVICES IN THE IAIP

- Shad rent rate of 1-1.5 USD/m2/month
- 132 MW Power supply with tariff rate of 0.018 – 0.032 USD/kwh
- 12000 m3/day Water supply with tariff 0.57 USD/m3/month
- Access road throughout the park
- Telecom and IT infrastructure
- Housing
- Park operation and management offices
- Training center
- Health center
- Police station and Fire Brigade
- One Stop Shop service (includes Investment Commission, banks, customs and revenue, Ethio-telecom, Electric Authority, etc)
- Full-time security services
- Greenery and landscaping

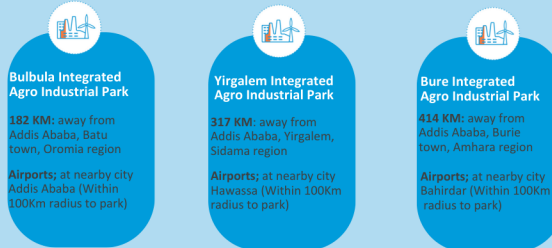

## RATIONALE FOR IAIP PROJECT

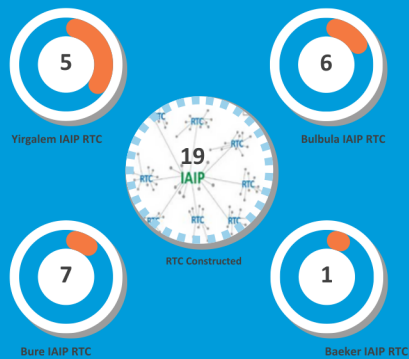

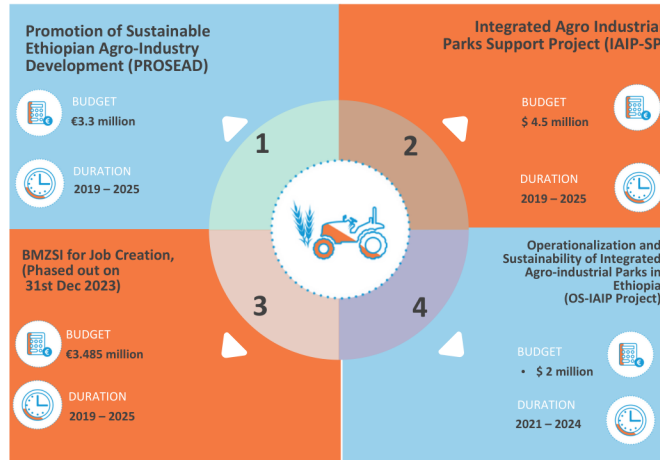
## RURAL TRANSFORMATION CENTERS

RTCs are geographic clusters of infrastructure and services, though on a smaller scale than IAIPs. Farmers deliver their produce and receive agricultural inputs like seed & fertilizer. At the RTCs, agricultural produce is collected, sorted, stored and may undergo primary processing before onward transport to IAIPs.



## UNIDO's Focus in the IAIPs

UNIDO is an instrumental partner to the Government of Ethiopia (GoE) in supervising the implementation of the IAIPs. This includes guiding the projects from the conceptualization phase to establishing governance structures, enhancing infrastructure, building capacity, and encouraging investments in the parks and related catchment areas.
